Strategy 1	Access to Technology	During lockdown in Summer 2020 it was clear one barrier to learning identified in our lockdown report was students access to technology and confidence using applications such as google classroom, lack of access has been a barrier to many of the disadvantaged students. Many reviews identify lack of technology as a barrier to successful remote instruction. It is important that support is provided to ensure that disadvantaged pupils – who are more likely to face these barriers – have access to technology. The use of bubbles on the return to the Academy restricts access to IT facilities further. By increasing the amount of portable devices available in school, which can also be directed home in the case of bubbles having to close for a period of time progress can be supported. Purchase of 30 chrome books and associated licenses/ dongles / trolleys for each bubble.
