Dear Parent/Carer,

As we near the end of the GCSE examinations I would like to take this opportunity to say how impressed I have been with the way that the students have approached the exams. Students have arrived on time and have been ready for each exam showing resilience and confidence. At the time that I am writing this letter we have had 100% attendance to all examinations.

Their time at The Gainsborough Academy is quickly coming to an end and there are several events taking place that I want to update you on.

Final exams - after the physics exam on Monday 16th June students will be able to leave school. If you have any concerns about this and need your son/daughter to remain in school until the end of the day, please contact the school. This includes the students who have the Spanish exam on Tuesday. They will be given resources so that they can complete home study.

Students who have the Spanish exam on Tuesday morning will be expected to attend the exam booster at 8 am and following the exam will be able to leave school. Again should you need your son/daughter to remain on site please contact us.

Revision Guides - if your son/daughter still has any revision guides at home these should be returned to school this week. There will be a collection basket at each morning booster session this week. If revision guides are not returned you will be billed for any which you still have as detailed in the original letter.

Prom (leavers) breakfast takes place on Thursday 26th June at 9.30 am – 11.00 am. This is an opportunity for students to celebrate the end of exams together and to sign shirts. Breakfast will be provided at this event and students will receive their leavers book. Students will be sent invites to this event over the next week.

Prom will take place on Tuesday 1st July at Hemswell Court. All students who are attending should have now paid for their tickets. Once the payment is made students can collect their physical ticket from Mrs Hoggarth. When they collect their tickets they will need to provide their menu choices and any dietary needs. Arrival time for the prom is from 6.30 pm with a 7.00 pm start and collection at 11.00 pm. Students have been sent this information by Mr Shaw.

Exam results day is Thursday 21st August, Students will be able to collect their results from school between 9.00 am - 10.30 am. Any results which are not collected will be posted home. Should any student wish another person to collect the results on their behalf, the student must email Mrs Metcalfe to confirm this in advance smetcalfe@gainsboroughacademy.com as we are unable to give the results to anyone else without written consent.
