Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to introduce our updated and structured homework policy for all students in Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8, and 9), which will be fully implemented from November 2025.

This new framework is designed to create a consistent and manageable workload, foster excellent study habits, and strengthen the partnership between students, teachers, and parents in supporting your child's learning journey.

Why Homework is Essential

Regular, meaningful homework is a vital part of a student's education. It reinforces classroom learning, builds independence, and prepares students for the rigours of future examinations. Our homework tasks are designed to achieve three key goals:

- Recall: To consolidate knowledge and embed key facts learned in class.
- Application: To use learned skills and knowledge in new or practical contexts.
- Extension: To challenge students to explore topics more deeply, conduct research, and prepare for upcoming lessons.

By establishing strong routines at home and school, students develop the organisation, resilience, and time-management skills that are fundamental for academic success.

Weekly Homework Timetable

We expect students to spend approximately 20-30 minutes per subject on their homework, totalling up to one hour per evening. You will find a copy of the homework calendar for students and links to the common online platforms enclosed at the end of this letter. Please display this at home to refer to when discussing homework completion with your child.

A Shared Responsibility: Our Expectations

For this policy to be successful, we all have a role to play. Below are our shared expectations.

Our Commitment (Teacher Expectations):

- To set meaningful homework that aligns with the timetable and curriculum.
- To provide clear, unambiguous instructions and success criteria.
- To ensure homework is accessible to all students, using online platforms effectively.
- To provide timely and constructive feedback to help students improve.
- To be available to support students who are having difficulty with their work.
- To support students by offering access to computer facilities in school



Student Expectations:

- To listen to instructions in class and check online platforms for homework details.
- To take responsibility for recording homework in their school diary
- · To complete and submit all homework by the deadline.
- To complete all work to the best of their ability.
- . To manage their time effectively, spending approximately 20-30 minutes per subject.
- To act on feedback provided by their teachers.
- To ask for help from their teacher before the deadline if they are finding the work challenging.

How You Can Support (Parent & Carer Expectations):

- Provide a suitable environment: Encourage your child to work in a quiet, dedicated space, away from distractions like television or mobile phones.
- Establish a routine: Help your child get into the habit of completing homework at a set time each evening.
- Show an interest: Ask your child about their homework and what they are learning. This values their effort and reinforces its importance.
- Encourage independence: Support your child by discussing ideas, but encourage them
 to complete the work themselves.
- Monitor workload: Familiarise yourself with the timetable below and contact us if you
 have concerns about the amount or difficulty of the work.

We firmly believe that by working together, we can help your child develop the skills and confidence to thrive. Thank you for your continued partnership and support.
